NOTICE OF SEIZURE / IMPOUNDMENT AND FORFEITURE

1. Notice of Seizure and/or Impoundment

Pursuant to § 11.8.2 of the Lower Elwha Klallam Tribe's Code for Seizure, Impoundment, and Forfeiture of Property (Seizure and Forfeiture Code), be advised that the Tribe has seized the properties or assets listed below:

- A. 2004 Mercury Sable sedan, silver in color, bearing Washington State plate number "BKP5493" (VIN # 1MEFM50U44A6600727) and registered to William J. Cagey seized on September 22, 2018;
- B. Approximately 112 grams of marijuana seized on September 22, 2018;
- C. A 50 gallon yellow and black plastic tote full of marijuana, inclusive of the marijuana contained therein, seized on September 22, 2018;
- D. 118 blister packs each containing approximately 1 gram of marijuana wax or oil (THC concentrates) seized on September 22, 2018;

- F. Drug paraphernalia seized on September 22, 2018, consisting of a digital scale, numerous clear plastic "Ziploc" type baggies, several dozen blister packs, a blue colored plastic marijuana grinder, two glass marijuana pipes, a yellow colored container of propane, and assorted plastic boxes;
- G. A "Samsung" brand cellular phone in an "Otterbox" case seized on September 22, 2018;
- H. Silver colored "brass" knuckles seized on September 22, 2018;
- I. A blue colored backpack seized on September 22, 2018; and
- J. A wood baton, natural in color with a white lanyard affixed to the grip approximately 18 inches in length and bearing an inscription of "wigger" seized on September 25, 2018;

Tribal law enforcement seized the items listed pursuant to criminal search warrant(s) based on probable cause that the registered owner of the vehicle, William J. Cagey was using the vehicle listed as item 1, to unlawfully possess, store, deliver, and/or transport controlled substances, paraphernalia, or contraband within or through the jurisdiction of the Lower Elwha Klallam Tribe. The items listed above were seized at the Elwha Justice Center, 341 Spokwes Drive, Port Angeles, Washington.

2. Notice of Forfeiture

The Tribe intends that the above named defendant forfeit to the Tribe any and all interest in the properties listed in Paragraph 1 constituting, or derived from, any proceeds obtained, directly or indirectly, as a result of Tribal criminal offense(s) committed by defendant, and shall further forfeit any and all interest in property, used or intended to be used, in any manner or part to commit, and to facilitate the commission of such offense(s).

If any forfeitable property, as a result of any act or omission of the above named defendant cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence, has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person, has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Lower Elwha Tribal Court, has been substantially diminished in value, or has been commingled with other property which cannot be subdivided without difficulty, it is the intent of the Tribe pursuant to the Seizure and Forfeiture Code to seek the forfeiture of any property of the defendant up to the value of the forfeitable properties.

3. Forfeiture Proceedings

A. A respondent owner/claimant to seized or impounded property, after being provided notice by mail has **twenty (20) days** after the date of mailing to file a verified answer with the Clerk of Court. Such answer shall include either a general denial or a brief description of the defense(s) asserted by the respondent owner/claimant. The answer must be attested to by the respondent owner/claimant by affixing his/her signature in the answer.

Failure to file a verified answer may result in a default order or may otherwise inhibit or restrict a respondent owner/claimant's ability to fully defend his/her interests in further court proceedings.

B. Upon the timely filing of a verified answer by the respondent owner/claimant, a hearing on the forfeiture shall be set no later than **thirty (30) days** of receipt of the verified answer or the date of sentencing if the forfeiture proceedings relate to property that is evidence in a pending

criminal case, whichever date is later. Notice of the hearing shall be by regular or certified mail.

4. Applicable Law

A copy of the Lower Elwha Lower Elwha Klallam Tribe's Code for Seizure, Impoundment, and Forfeiture of Property (2011) is attached hereto.
