OTHER RESTRICTIONS: AS PER ANNUAL REG. #S19-001, ADDITIONALLY:

1. HARVEST IS LIMITED TO CLAMS 1.5 INCHES IN LENGTH OR GREATER.
2. COMMERCIALY HARVESTED CLAMS MUST BE SOLD WITHIN 24 HOURS OF THE CLOSE OF THE FISHERY, OR PLACED IN REFRIGERATED CONTAINERS.
3. A LABEL ISSUED BY THE FISHERIES OFFICE MUST BE AFFIXED TO EACH BAG OR CONTAINER OF COMMERCIALY HARVESTED CLAMS IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE HARVEST.
4. TRIBAL HARVESTERS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLY WITH PROVISIONS OF THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TRIBES AND THE NAVY.
5. ACCESS IS LIMITED, PLEASE CONTACT YOUR TRIBAL FISHERIES OFFICE TO OBTAIN YOUR TURN FOR HARVESTING.
6. EACH LICENSED ELWHA TRIBAL FISHER MAY BE ASSISTED BY NO MORE THAN ONE ASSISTANT, EITHER A SPOUSE OR RELATIVE (MAY BE NON-MEMBER).
7. ALL ELWHA TRIBAL MEMBERS MUST MAKE CONTACT WITH MONITOR BEFORE STARTING DIG. ALL ELWHA TRIBAL FISHERS MUST REPORT THEIR HARVEST TO THE MONITOR BEFORE LEAVING THE BEACH. FAILURE TO COMPLY THESE PROVISION WILL BE A VIOLATION OF THIS REGULATION.
8. ALL DIGGERS PLANNING TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS FISHERY MUST NOTIFY THIS OFFICE A MINIMUM OF 48 HOURS IN ADVANCE TO THE

START OF THE FISHERY. IF THE FISHERY STARTS ON THE WEEKEND,  
DIGGERS MUST NOTIFY THIS OFFICE BY 9:00 AM THURSDAY.
