LAWFUL GEAR: HOOK AND LINE GEAR PER THE ANNUAL TROLL REGULATION (#F21-009) WHICH SUPERCEDES THESE REGULATIONS WHERE APPLICABLE:

A. Hand lines: Maximum 2 single or 1 treble hook per line; all hooks must be barbless. Maximum of two lines per fisher.

B. Salmon troll gear: Maximum of 8 lines per vessel; maximum of 72 hooks per vessel. All hooks must be barbless.

EFFECTIVE DATES: JULY 11, 2021 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 4, 2021
OPEN UNTIL 1,500 CHINOOK QUOTA IS ACHIEVED

DAYS/HOURS: OPEN DAYLIGHT HOURS ONLY

OTHER RESTRICTIONS

- 1) PER REGULATION #F21-015
- 2) RELEASE ALL CHUM SALMON
- 3) ALL CHINOOK MEASURING LESS THAN 22 INCHES MUST BE RELEASED UNHARMED
- 4) DURING COMMERCIAL TROLL FISHERIES, NO MORE THAN TWO UNDERSIZES CHINOOK SALMON PER FISHER MAY BE KEPT DAILY FOR TAKE-HOME SUBSISTENCE PURPOSES
- 5) TROLL GEAR MUST NOT BE OPERATED CLOSER THAN 1,000 FEET FROM ANY STREAM OR RIVER MOUTH, OR AROUND ALL WATERS WITHIN CHANNELS CREATED BY EXPOSED TIDELANDS, INCLUDING DOSEWALLIPS, DUCKABUSH, AND HAMMA HAMMA RIVERS
- 6) ALL CATCH MUST BE REPORTED ON FISH TICKETS ON ROADSIDE SALE REPORTING FORMS
- 7) ALL CATCH MUST BE MADE AVAILABLE TO LOWER ELWHA FISHERIES
