2) SALMON TROLL GEAR: MAXIMUM OF 8 LINES PER VESSEL;
ALL HOOKS MUST BE BARBLESS.

EFFECTIVE DATES: JULY 10TH THROUGH SEPTEMBER 03, 2022

DAYS/HOURS: DAYLIGHT HOURS ONLY

OTHER RESTRICTIONS: 2) RELEASE ALL CHUM SALMON.
3) ALL CHINOOK MEASURING LESS THAN 22 INCHES MUST BE
RELEASED UNHARMED.
4) DURING COMMERCIAL TROLL FISHERIES, NO MORE THAN
TWO UNDERSIZE CHINOOK SALMON PER FISHER MAY BE
KEPT DAILY FOR TAKE-HOME SUBSISTENCE PURPOSES.
3) TROLL GEAR MUST NOT BE OPERATED CLOSER THAN 1,000
FEET FROM ANY STREAM OR RIVER MOUTH, AND AROUND
ALL WATERS WITHIN CHANNELS CREATED BY EXPOSED
TIDELANDS, INCLUDING THE DOSEWALLIPS, DUCKABUSH
AND HAMMA HAMMA RIVERS.
4) ALL CATCH MUST BE REPORTED ON FISH TICKETS
OR ROADSIDE SALE REPORTING FORMS.
5) ALL CATCH MUST BE MADE AVAILABLE TO LEKT FISHERIES
STAFF FOR SAMPLING PURPOSES.
