EFFECTIVE DATES: JULY 2 THROUGH JULY 31, 2024

DAYS/HOURS: THE FISHERY WILL OPEN TUESDAY  
JULY 2ND AND CONTINUE THROUGH  
WEDNESDAY JULY 31ST PROVIDED  
THAT THE FISHERY FOR EACH TRIBE  
MAY CLOSE SOONER IF THE INDIVIDUAL  
TRIBAL TARGET HARVEST IS TAKEN  
PRIOR TO THIS DATE.

DAILY OPENING WILL OCCUR FROM  
SUNRISE TO SUNSET EACH DAY.

OTHER RESTRICTIONS: AS PER REG. #S24-003, ADDITIONALLY:

1. SHRIMP POTS: THE MAXIMUM TOTAL NUMBER OF POTS AND/OR RING  
NETS COMBINED WILL BE 5 POTS. SHRIMP POTS  
REGISTERED TO A PARTICULAR VESSEL MUST BE SET AND PULLED  
BY THAT VESSEL, UNLESS OTHERWISE APPROVED BY THE FISHERIES  
OFFICE.
2. ALL POTS AND RING NETS SHALL HAVE BUOYS ATTACHED. BUOYS MAY BE  
ANY COLOR EXCEPT YELLOW OR ANY COMBINATION OF RED AND WHITE.  
BUOYS MUST REMAIN FLOATING AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT DURING EXTREME  
TIDES.  
BUOYS WILL ALSO BE MARKED WITH THE TRIBE'S INITIALS AND WITH  
THE FISHER'S ID NUMBER. BUOY LINES WILL BE WEIGHTED TO KEEP  
THE LINES FROM FLOATING.
3. THE DAILY SUBSISTENCE HARVEST LIMIT IS 20 LBS PER FISHER  
AND 40 POUNDS PER BOAT.  
THE CATCH MUST BE RECORDED ON A SUBSISTENCE CARD PRIOR TO  
LEAVING THE HARVEST AREA.
4. ALL FISHERS MUST BE PREPARED TO HAUL OUT ANY REFUSE CREATED BY  
THEIR OWN ACTIONS DURING AND IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE FISHERY.  
REFUSE DISPOSAL FACILITIES MAY BE LIMITED IN CERTAIN AREAS OF  
HOOD CANAL.

HARVEST RESTRICTIONS:

1) THE ELWHA TRIBAL HARVEST  
FOR AREA 27A AND 27B IS 1300 LBS FOR BOTH AREAS

COMBINED.

JUSTIFICATION: HARVEST 1300 LBS SUBSISTENCE QUOTA.
