3. ANY PORTION OF LANDED CATCH (UP TO 100 POUNDS)
THAT EXCEEDS THE LANDING LIMIT MUST
BE DELIVERED TO THE TRIBE FOR CEREMONIAL PURPOSES.
4. NO MORE THAN 4 FISH PER VESSEL FOR TAKE HOME
PURPOSES.
